Financing of social infrastructure

At the Address 2012 the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan Nursultan Nazarbayev, declared the principal vector of development of Kazakhstan in the coming decades - the development of the socio-economic modernization, improving the welfare of the people. For Kazakhstan it is vitally important to find an optimal balance between economic success and providing public goods through the socio-economic modernization, which is impossible without the development of social infrastructure.

✓ **Social infrastructure** - a set of industries and businesses, providing a functionally normal activity of the population. The development and effective functioning of the objects included in the social infrastructure, their availability to the population - an important condition for improving the level and quality of life of the country.

✓ **Social modernization** - one of the key vectors of state development

➤ **Financing of social infrastructure in Kazakhstan is carried out at the expense of the state and local budget**

➤ **In addition, implemented a number of government programs aimed at improving and ensuring equal access to social infrastructure**

development and improvement of the Unified National Health System;


improvement of medical and pharmaceutical education, the development of medical science and pharmaceutical activities

“Balapan” program on providing children with preschool education and training for 2010-2014

➤ **THE PROGRAM GOAL** - meet the needs of the population in quality preschool services, education and training. The program will ensure the adoption of drastic measures to reduce the shortage of pre-school organizations in the country.

➤ **The program targets:**



provide up to 2015 70% of preschool age children by preschool education and training;


provide till 2015 complete coverage of 5 – 6-year old children with preschool preparation in the education organizations;

make full provision of preschool institutions with qualified personnel and the continuous improvement of their skills

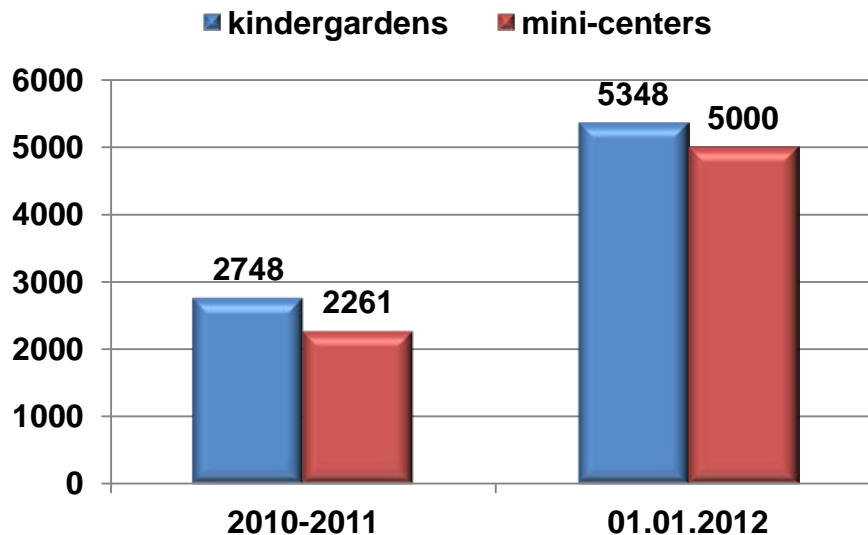

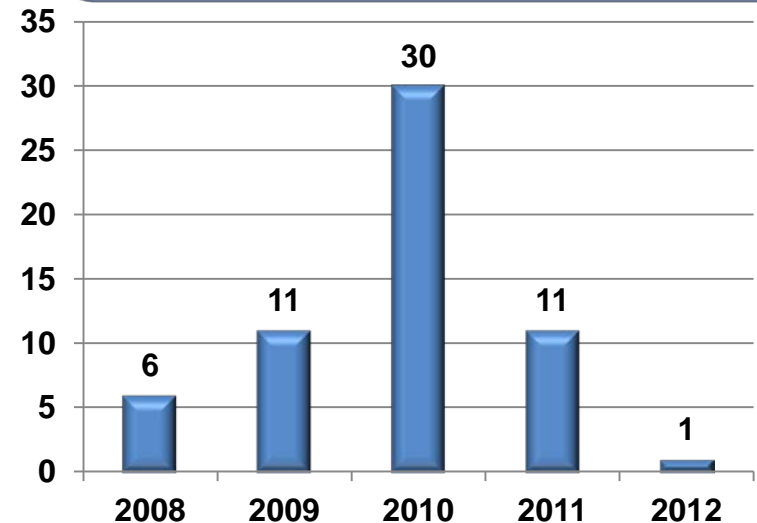
Education

Within implementation of the “Balapan” program in comparison with 2010 the network of the preschool organizations is increased by 1650 units (487 kindergartens, 1163 mini-centers)

According to the program of “100 schools, 100 hospitals” 59 objects for the sum of 148,8 billion tenge are built.

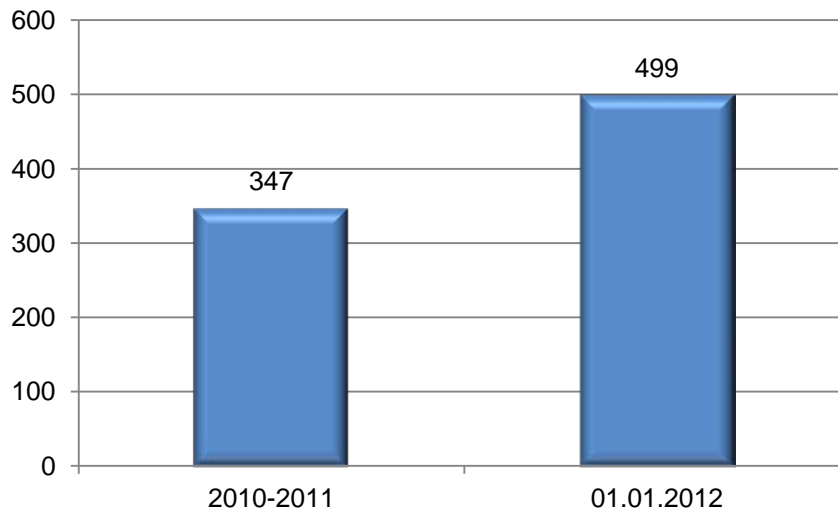


The first results

Placement of state orders under the "Balapan" program from the national budget has increased the network of private gardens on 152 units or 43.8%, and their number in 2012 amounted to 499 units.

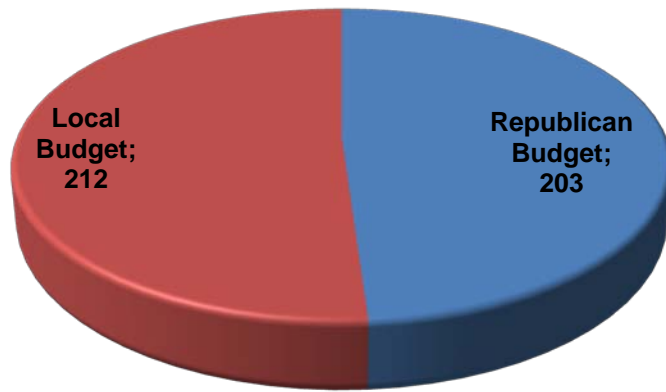

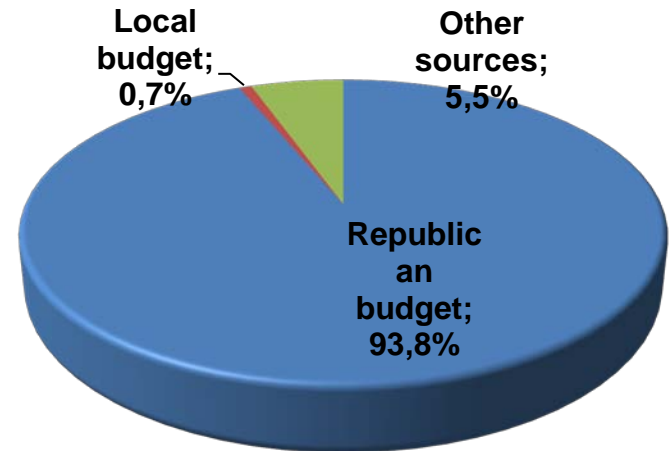
Education

In order to address the problem of schools in 2012-2014 at the expense of Republican Budget it is planned to build 203 schools, 212 - by Local Budget.
